THE PROJECT

The ERADICATING II project aims to enhance prevention and multi-agency cooperation against labour trafficking. It focuses on building the capacity of law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, labour inspectors, and first-line practitioners to detect, identify, protect, and refer victims. Key goals include improving cross-border investigations, enhancing cooperation among various actors, and addressing the risks to Ukrainian refugees.

The project is funded with support from the European Commission under the Internal Security Fund (ISF) and has a duration of 24 months (01/12/2023-30/11/2025).

Strengthening skills across Europe

Several training activities have taken place across Europe, bringing together law enforcement, labor inspectors, prosecutors and frontline professionals. The trainings focused on the key skills and knowledge needed for professionals to identify and protect victims or potential victims of trafficking.

Participants engaged in lectures, case studies, group discussions, and hands-on workshops, all designed to reinforce practical skills—from digital forensics to trauma-informed approaches. These interactive elements brought learning to life, reflecting the complex realities of trafficking response.


