THE PROJECT

The ERADICATING II project aims to enhance prevention and multi-agency cooperation against labour trafficking. It focuses on building the capacity of law enforcement agencies, prosecutors, labour inspectors, and first-line practitioners to detect, identify, protect, and refer victims. Key goals include improving cross-border investigations, enhancing cooperation among various actors, and addressing the risks to Ukrainian refugees.

The project is funded with support from the European Commission under the Internal Security Fund (ISF) and has a duration of 26 months (01/12/2023-31/1/2026).




OUR OUTCOMES

ERADICATING II has delivered concrete results in strengthening Europe's response to labour trafficking. Through coordinated national trainings and a large-scale Master Simulation Exercise, the project reached over 700 professionals across six EU countries, significantly improving their capacity to identify labour exploitation, apply victim-centred approaches, and cooperate effectively across agencies and borders.

Key project outputs include the development of comprehensive online learning materials and two practical pocket-size guides—one for frontline professionals and one for the general public—providing clear guidance on risk indicators, victims' rights, and referral procedures. These tools directly support early detection, timely referral, and victim protection in daily professional practice.
